**WEATHER:** Friday: Mostly cloudy skies with a high of 57. Winds 8-15 mph out of the north. Saturday: Mostly sunny skies with a high of 57. Winds 8-15 mph out of the north. Sunday: Mostly sunny skies with a high of 74. Winds 15-25 mph out of the south.

**NOTES:** Steve Stricker entered the final round tied for the lead with Brandt Jobe , but with back-to-back birdies on Nos. 1 and 2 and a bogey on No. 1 by Jobe, Stricker built a three-shot cushion and had a multi-shot lead for the remainder of the round. He finished at 13-under 197 for his first victory at the inaugural Sanford International and third victory on PGA TOUR Champions. It was the second time Stricker had converted a second-round lead/co-lead into a victory and in 34 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions, he had only recorded one round over par. Stricker now owns three victories on PGA TOUR Champions (Sanford International, Rapiscan Systems Classic, Cologuard Classic) and has top-five finishes in each of his seven starts this season. Stricker earned \$270, 000 and increased his season total to\$1,196,235 moving to No. 9 in the Charles Schwab Cup.
